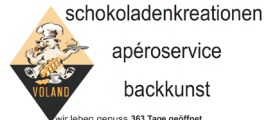

Course Information	Round of 1 km (See map on page 8) Boys 3 rounds (3 km) / Team competition (3 x 2 km) Girls 2 rounds (2 km) / Team competition (3 x 1 km)
Entries	only by FIS Entry System
Entry Fee	The entry fee is EUR 10.- per athlete and EUR 30.- per team (boys) and EUR 30.- (girls) and is calculated according to the official start list in each event.
Deadline individual competition	2 hours before TCM (Friday)
Deadline team competitions	Saturday 19:00

Quota	six (6) athletes per class and nation
Team competition	3 athletes by team A mix between women + men is not allowed Mix between nations is possible Nordic combined athletes can compete in Ski jumping, but they need a valid FIS Code (and the other way around)

Awards ceremony	at the jumping stadium

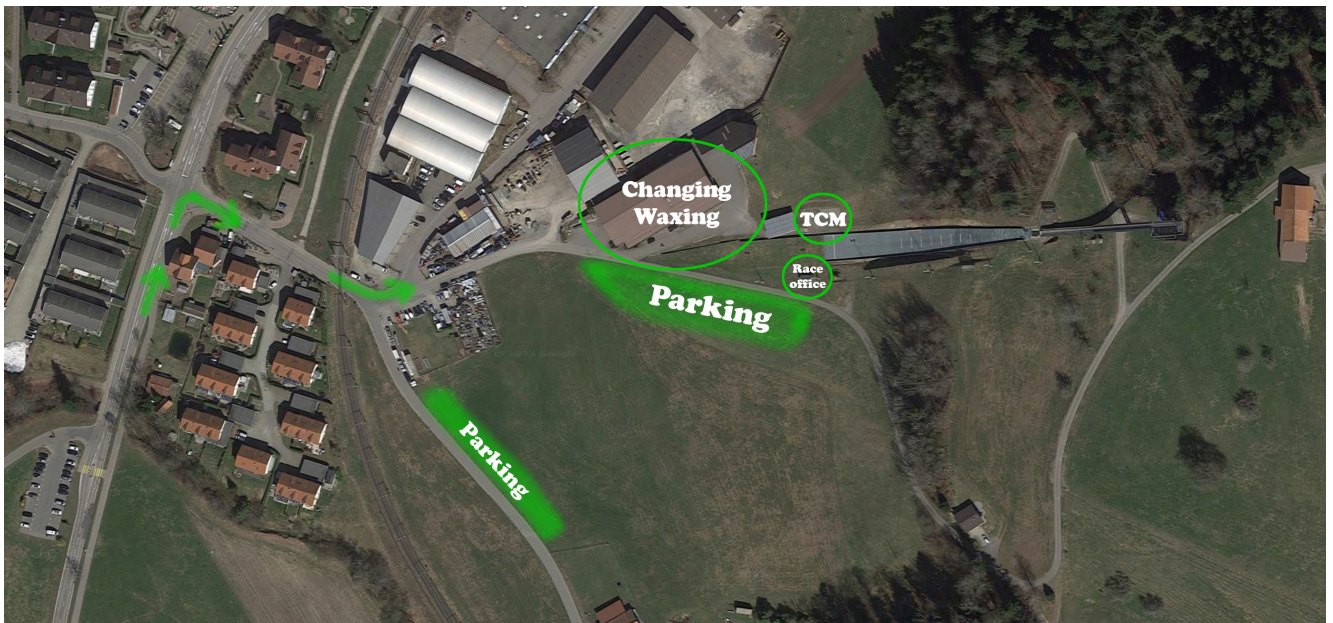
